World Food Programme









WFP's Building Blocks project is the humanitarian sector's largest **blockchain-based cash distribution system**, leveraging blockchain to coordinate with other humanitarian agencies and transfer cash assistance to refugees securely and efficiently.

The project provides recipients with a blockchain-based e-wallet to make cash transfers faster, cheaper and more secure, allowing WFP to transact directly without the need for banks or other financial institutions.

In 2020, WFP's Building Blocks has used blockchain technology to distribute cash-based assistance transactions to **Rohingya refugees** in Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh, and **Syrian refugees** in Jordan.









Cloud to Street is a remote sensing platform to predict, map and analyze floods in real time.

By using global satellite imagery and cloud computing, it analyses flooding on the ground and continuously estimates flood probabilities. As the platform is remote and automated, the maps and analytics are affordable, fast, and accessible for governments and aid agencies left off of traditional maps.

In 2020, Cloud to Street identified over **23,500 km**² of floodprone land, helping protect **1.2 million people** at risk or impacted by a major flood event.







WFP's H2Grow project brings locally adaptable and affordable hydroponic solutions to vulnerable communities around the world. It employs the soilless, water-efficient agricultural technique that enables plant growth in harsh environments. By developing lowtech systems from local materials, growing fresh vegetables or animal feed in deserts, refugee camps or urban informal settlements, H2Grow supports food-insecure families to increase their access to fresh food and raise their income.

In 2020, H2Grow directly impacted more than **26,500 people in nine countries**, many of them women and children. **Three new countries** are already funded and in the preparation phase.

An Asset-Backed Loan model is being piloted in Kenya now!

Post-Harvest Loss Reduction (PHL) is a joint venture between WFP Programme and the WFP Innovation Accelerator that supports country offices to scale PHL sustainable business models, with the aim to improve household food security and income for smallholder farmers, done in partnership with different players including governments, private sector, and other relevant institutions.

Participating farmers have been able to **reduce drastically their post-harvest losses**, leading to a threefold increase in their income. This has greatly impacted food security in local communities and improved nutrition for many families.









PRE-SCALE PROJECT



WFP Somalia's e-shop app enables retailers to sell in a virtual store, and for customers to redeem their WFP cashbased assistance by shopping online and having their food delivered directly to them, while maintaining physical distance during the COVID-19 pandemic.

WFP e-Shop is available Somalia-wide reaching **124,137 e-Shop customers** who have carried out US\$ 16.2 million transactions since its launch.

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WFP Innovation Impact Fund

A \$100M social impact venture debt fund for startups, NGOs and WFP innovations in developing countries, pooling donor funds and private investors' money towards scalable innovations as an innovative mechanism to create massive social impact.

Blended finance fund powered by WFP Innovation Accelerator, selectively open to strategic partners.

The Big Idea

- Focus on disruptive, investable and scalable startups, NGOs and/or **WFP** Innovations
- Leverage WFP's field operations in 88 developing countries, and the Accelerator's organisation and ecosystem to boost their growth and impact
- Provide access to catalytic funds to accelerate their scalability, boosting their impact and growth
- Deliver lasting social impact, open sourcing innovations, multiplying investments and reinvesting returns

Innovators repay the Fund with interest from operational earnings or after raising capital as they accelerate growth, allowing the Fund to plow back investments and/or repay original investors



ShareTheMeal (STM) is WFP's fundraising app, allowing smartphone users to provide children with vital nutrition through a simple tap on their phones.

It costs just **EUR 0.70** to feed one child for a day. Free to download, the award-winning app is a pioneering way for people to join WFP's efforts in creating a world without hunger.

The ShareTheMeal community has shared over **125 million meals** with those most in need in over **30** different **countries**.

It was named by both **Google** and **Apple** as one of the <u>Best Apps of 2020</u>, and got a <u>special shout out</u> from Apple CEO Tim Cook.
